You can find the steps required to complete this training, the number of teachers currently training, links to important resources, and the breakdown of badges earned.




Finding your group





Finding your group

If this is your first time on Code65, join the Apple Teacher PD group by tapping on “Enter Code” and entering in **GR9RM**.


Add the code to your profile by tapping on “**Add Code to my profile**”. Once you have added the group code to your profile, tap on the green “**View Group**” button to view your group.

If you are returning to your group select “**My Groups**” and then choose *Apple Teacher Online PD*.



The news feed


Your group page defaults to show the news feed when you enter it. All of the work that you submit can be kept private, meaning that other members of this group cannot see it. Work that is not marked private will be posted to the group news feed, as shown below.


The news feed

Tapping on a submission in the news feed opens it in a new window with its given description. From this window, you can react to each other's work by tapping on the words and phrases on the right side of the submission. Tap on the "X" in the top right corner of the screen to close this window and return to the news feed.

Working on a challenge

Once you begin a challenge, you are taken to the activity's directions. The activities offered in this training all include links to helpful resources. To open a link (top right), simply tap on its blue text.

Each activity has multiple steps to complete, listed in blue at the bottom of the screenshot. To view a step, tap on it once. A window will appear with the full instructions for that step.

Some of these steps are links to download the iOS guide needed for the challenge. This is signified by a link icon (🔗) listed next to the step's title. When tapping on these steps, you will be taken to a new window where you can download the required documents.

Sharing your work file

Follow the instructions to complete the challenge on your device. Remember to save your work often.

Option 1 If you have an iCloud account and are familiar with how it works, save your file to your iCloud Drive.


Option 2 If you are unfamiliar with iCloud, prepare to post by sharing a rendered version of your file to the App folder (e.g. Pages, Keynote) on your iPad. For iMovie or Clips challenges, save to the Keynote folder.

Later when you submit your work, you will upload it from this same folder.

Submitting your work

When you are ready to submit your completed project, scroll below the instructions. Enter a submission name and description, and tap on **“Pick File”** to attach your work.

A new window will appear. Make sure **“Upload from your device”** is selected on the left, and tap on the blue **“Choose File”** button, then on **“Browse.”**



If you saved your file to iCloud, tap on **“iCloud Drive”** on the left menu and find and attach the file.


If you saved your file to an App folder (e.g. Pages, Keynote) on your device, tap on **“On My iPad”** on the left menu, then on the Name of the App folder. Find and attach your file.



Submitting your work


Make sure your file is successfully attached, and your submission has a name and description. If you wish for your submission to remain private, check the corresponding box. Tap on the green **“Submit”** button to submit your work.

You have now successfully finished submitting your challenge work! Tap on **“Find something new in your group”** to go back to your playlists.
